

DADH 2018 Poster Format Description and Related Rules

1. Time and place of poster presentation:

- i. Poster location: DILA GC001 and GC002 curved walkway.
- ii. Posting time: December 19th (Wednesday): 9:00-12:00
- iii. Poster presentation time: December 20th (Thursday): 13:50-15:10
- iv. Poster withdrawal time: December 21st (Friday): 18:00-19:00

2. Poster Content and Format:

- i. Those presentations accepted by the conference as “poster format” should be formatted as follows: A0 poster (84cm wide and 119cm long), posted on the day of the conference.
- ii. Poster frame: The poster layout should be 90cm wide and 150cm long. The poster frame should have a total length of 200 cm.
- iii. The content can be freely expressed, but it ought to be mainly based on the content of the paper.
- iv. At least one author must be present during the poster presentation period, wearing a name badge, in order to explain the content.
- v. The contents of the poster should include: title, author information (name, organization/department/title, contact details), and the main arguments. As there will be many non-Chinese speaking participants in this session, the poster content needs to be presented in English.
- vi. The poster is based on the twin principles of aesthetics and legibility. The chart needs to be presented in good resolution.

3. Important Points:

- i. Please prepare your poster beforehand and bring it to the conference.
- ii. Thumbtacks and pushpins will be available on site. If you need any other art and craft tools, please bring your own.
- iii. There will be no audio-visual projection equipment or power cords or tables and chairs at the poster presentation site. If you need to display relevant information on a laptop computer or tablet, please charge them yourself.
- iv. If the poster is not removed within the time limit, it will be disposed of by the conference staff and will not be retained or returned to the publisher.
